





JMB Mission

EMPOWERMENT THROUGH RELATIONSHIPS

- Empowering our students starts with authentic relationships.
- Building authentic relationships starts with knowing yourself and knowing your kids.
- Challenge #1:
 - Visualize one student you've taught from the past. Consider 10 things you know about this student as a person and write them down.
 - How easy or difficult was that?
 - How often could you do this for every student you teach?
- Challenge #2: <u>Affirming our Identities</u> Identity Webs
 - Character identity web
 - Reflect and participate during the identity web activity.
